




14 QUICK LINKS SECTION GUIDELINES


This section covers how to apply new icons to the quick links bar along with a quick over view of the default icons already applied to the Quick Links Bar.


14.1 DEFAULT CURSORS


 Hide/Show Ribbon - The ribbon menu can be hidden when not in use, this then allowing desktops or charts to be maximized and creating a bigger work space. To hide the ribbon select the *Ribbon* button on the **Quick Links Bar** and this will remove the ribbon from the application providing a bigger work space. If you want to retrieve the *Ribbon* simply depress the ribbon button situated on the **Quick Links Bar**.


 New Chart - To create a new chart, simply select the *New Chart* Icon situated on the **Quick Links Bar**. This will create a new chart within the active desktop again with the default settings applied i.e. EURUSD, timeframe, and chart type applied.


 New Desktop - To create a new desktop, select the *New Desktop* Icon situated on the **Quick Links Bar**. This will create a new desktop in a new tab entitled 'New Desktop x' it will contain a single chart with the default settings applied i.e. EURUSD, timeframe, and chart type applied.


 Open Slide - The *Open Slide* stores the desktops in the order they were closed and keeps them hidden in order to prevent space being used for non-required desktops. To open a desktop, click the *Open Slide* button situated on the **Quick Links Bar** and click the required desktop. This will open up the desktop and place it along the desktop tab; it will also become the active desktop once opened.

 Save Desktop – This feature saves any changes made to the current/active desktop. By selecting the icon this will save all the amendments that have been made to active desktop since the application has been launched. To save changes to the active desktop select the *Save Desktop* button located on the **Quick Links Bar**.

 Arrow Cursor – The *arrow cursor* is the default cursor when using the application, the arrow cursor is situated on the **Quick Links Bar**. When the Arrow cursor is not in use the icon will not be depressed.

 Crosshair cursor – The *Crosshair cursor* is used to retrieve or view a value anywhere from the chart area. The values are coordinated by the x and y axis. To select the Crosshair cursor. depress the button situated on the **Quick Links Bar**.

 Rubber Cursor – The *Rubber cursor* is a quicker way for a user to remove an unwanted line or annotation from a chart. To enable the rubber cursor click the Rubber button situated on the **Quick Links Bar**, the cursor will change from an arrow to a rubber image.

 Zoom Function - This *Zoom Cursor* allows the enhancement of the graph by either zooming visually or zooming by date. The automatic zoom uses the mouse to select the zoom range. To turn on the *Zoom Function* select the zoom button on the **Quick Links Bar**. Click and drag on the chart to outline the data to be included in the zoom area. To go zoom out of an area simply right click on the mouse.

14.2 HOW TO DRAG & DROP FUNCTIONS INTO THE QUICK LINKS BAR

Maverick allows you to customize the Quick Links bar to be able to access important features from the application quick and easy.

In order to customise your **Quick Links** Bar follow the steps bellow:

Click on an icon you wish to apply to the **Quick Links** bar

Drag functionality from the main ribbon over to the clear area (See screenshot below)

An example is shown below:

Go to **TA Tools** Tab, Click on the *Pullback Line* but make sure your finger does not release off the mouse

Once selected drag over to the left hand side of the application where the *Quick Links* Bar is situated

Drop into the grey area of the Quick Links Bar
